

## BEADED SALAMANDERS & LIZARDS

Sometimes salamanders and lizards get confused becaue they have a similar body shape. But lizards are dry, scaly, live on land, and have claws. On the other hand, salamanders are smooth, slimy, and prefer water.



## MATERIALS YOU'LL NEED:

- Pony Beads
- String or Ribbon (Plastic lanyard "boondoggl" works the best)
- Tape (recommended)




**STEP 1:** Cut your rope about 4 ft long. To make it easier, loop through a keyring and tape to a table.



**STEP 3:** Pull both ends of the rope at the same time to tighten the bead at the top. Make sure you maintain about an equal legnth of rope on both sides.



**STEP 5:** After the 4th row, thread 2 beads for the leg along with 3 beads for the toes. But only thread back the other way through the first two beads you put in (the legs).



**STEP 2:** Thread one bead through the end, then take the other end and thread it back the other way through the same bead.



**STEP 4:** Follow the template on the right to continue building the head. If you have trouble threading, try taping the ends of your rope.

**STEP 6:** Continue following the pattern to build an arm on the other side, followed by the rest of the body.
