

BUILD A BIRD FEEDER

The easiest way to attract a bird near your window or yard is to leave a snack for them! Contrary to popular belief, bread is NOT good to feed birds. Learn how to make this simple feeder with foods that are safe and nutritious for your feathered friends!

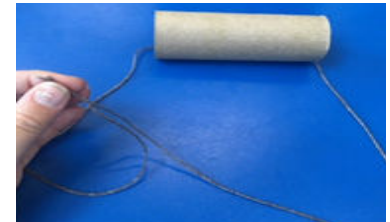


MATERIALS YOU'LL NEED:

- Toilet paper roll
- String
- Bird seed
- Crisco or peanut butter
- Knife

STEP 1

Thread a string through the paper roll. Tie the strings together in a knot.



STEP 2

Lightly spread Crisco or peanut butter all over the roll. Try putting two fingers inside to help you turn the roll as you spread.



STEP 3

Put your birdseed in a plate or bowl big enough to roll your tube in. Use fingers from both hands inside the ends of the tube!



STEP 4

Hang in your yard or front stoop to attract local birds!

CAN'T GET BIRD SEED?

Other snacks safe for birds to eat include cherries, apples, raisins, pears, berries, oranges, corn, and unsalted peanuts. Get creative- you can simply use string and toothpicks to hang these items too!
